
#### > The Insights






Total 96 % of the faculties were sure that sufficient reference material, related books and other resources are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus in the


library. Only 4 % of faculties are disagree about sufficiency of material availability, the issue will be further addressed by making library committee members work on the same.






#### **YEAR 2023-24**






### 3.3 OVERALL RATING OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS

After reviewing all the feedback provided, it's evident that the majority of comments were positive and complimentary. The college is highly appreciated for its excellent faculty, effective teaching methods, and supportive environment. Students value the disciplined and peaceful campus, along with the strong teacher-student bond that fosters academic growth. Students appreciated online admission process and fees collection. The institution actively encourages participation in extracurricular activities, contributing to student engagement. Additionally, the spacious campus and well-maintained cricket ground are notable positives, particularly for sports enthusiasts.

However, several areas need improvement. Sports facilities, including the absence of a PTI & dedicated coach for various sports. Moreover, students have highlighted limited library resources and vacant post of librarian. Addressing these concerns could significantly enhance the overall student experience and institutional effectiveness.


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


#### **Employer Feedback Analysis Report 2023-24**


The employer feedback collected for the academic year 2023-24 demonstrates a generally positive assessment of the curriculum and student proficiency. Total 16 responses were received. Most employers rated key areas including course relevance to the program, sufficiency of industry-related content, alignment of topics with industry needs, subject offerings in specialization streams, and the relevance of experiments to real-life applications predominantly as "Agree," with a smaller proportion indicating "Strongly Agree." No ratings of "Disagree" or "Strongly Disagree" were recorded in any parameter, confirming strong employer approval of the curriculum structure and delivery. The applicability of domains and tools used in designing experiments also received generally favourable feedback, though with a slightly higher incidence of neutral responses.


Some neutral responses were noted mainly in the areas of competencies/outcomes related to course content and the applicability of experimental tools and domains, suggesting opportunities for further refinement and clearer alignment with industry practices in these areas. Additionally, employers recommended the inclusion of new courses and skill-building opportunities within the curriculum specifically highlighting SAP-ERP, other IT-related skill development, Data Analytics, Digital Marketing Practical Aspects, Leadership Skills, Design Thinking, and Communication Skills. Overall, the data confirm that the institution's courses are well-aligned with industry expectations and that graduates are viewed as competent and well-prepared for the workplace. In conclusion, the feedback validates a strong level of employer satisfaction and the relevance and effectiveness of the current educational offerings, while highlighting both scope for ongoing enhancements in competency-related domains and opportunities to expand the curriculum in line with emerging industry trends and skill requirements.









### **Alumni Feedback Analysis Report 2023-24**

Alumni feedback from Gujarat Arts and Commerce College (Evening), Ahmedabad, reveals a largely positive assessment of the academic experience while also highlighting a few areas requiring attention. Alumni expressed high satisfaction with the admission process, teaching and learning quality, and the competence of faculty, often rating these aspects at the highest level. Institutional support in areas such as library, classrooms, and academic programs was generally found to be adequate. However, several respondents pointed out the need for improvement in infrastructure—including computer facilities, internet connectivity, laboratory resources, and sports/cultural amenities—indicating inconsistencies in access and quality. Ratings for curriculum relevance to industry needs and industry-academia exposure were mixed; a few alumni felt the curriculum was insufficiently aligned with practical/employability requirements, and called for updates such as more industry-relevant content, practical training, field visits, digital and communication skill modules, and exposure to modern tools.

Alumni engagement initiatives were well received, with most respondents expressing pride in their association with the institution and willingness to support its activities through mentoring, guest lectures, alumni meet, and—in some cases—offering internships or job opportunities. Notably, alumni achievements covered areas like cultural competitions, leadership, and professional success, reflecting the positive impact of their college experience. Among the suggestions offered were shortening the curriculum, introducing digital teaching methods, and organizing industry expert sessions and workshops. Many also recommended enhancing placement support and career guidance, updating syllabi with more practical/real-world content, and encouraging holistic student development by balancing academics with extracurricular involvement. Memorable moments described by alumni often centered around participation in NSS, NCC, cultural festivals, and group projects, underscoring the broader developmental role played by the college.

In summary, the institution is regarded as supportive and academically strong, with committed faculty and responsive engagement practices. Going forward, it is recommended to prioritize ongoing improvements in infrastructure (especially IT and sports facilities), strengthen the industry interface and employability focus within the curriculum, and harness alumni expertise to support current students. Regular review of teaching methods, deeper practical exposure, and enhancement of placement and career guidance services will further bolster the institution's reputation and relevance for future learners.
