Student's Training

As per the Resolution of the Education Department, Government dated 30/05/2023, the "Student Entrepreneurship Policy 2023-24" has been implemented. The main objective of this policy is to develop an entrepreneurial mindset among students and to motivate them towards self-employment, which is an important initiative of the Government.

The college nominated a total of **5 students** to participate in the Entrepreneurship Development Training Programme organized. The main objective of this training was to develop entrepreneurial thinking among students, to provide understanding for preparing business plans from innovative ideas, and to promote startup culture.

All nominated students attended the training programme regularly. During the training, experts provided guidance on important aspects such as idea generation, business model development, market survey, financial planning, intellectual property rights, and available support for startups. Through interactive activities and practical sessions, students were motivated to initiate entrepreneurial ventures.

As an outcome of the training programme, out of the 5 participating students, **3 students prepared and submitted their business proposals**. The proposals have been forwarded for evaluation under the Student Entrepreneurship Policy. Out of 3 students who has submitted business proposal **2 Students presented their business idea and proposal**. One students from our college received Rs. 40000/- as seed capital in form grant from Education Department of the Government of Gujarat. This clearly indicates that the programme was not only informative but also successful in developing a practical approach among the students.

As a result of this programme, awareness regarding self-employment, innovation, and self-reliance has increased among students. The college's initiative in nominating and encouraging students contributed to their capacity building and fostered a positive attitude towards entrepreneurship. Overall, the training programme proved to be highly beneficial and goal-oriented for the students.

Food Fest - 2023

The Gujarat Arts and Commerce College (Evening) Food Fest took place on 04-08-2023 during 1 pm to 4 pm, showcasing a diverse array of culinary delights and providing an opportunity for students to come together and celebrate their love for food. The event was jointly organized by IQAC, Aazadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, Collegiate Women's Development Cell (CWDC) and Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC), it aimed to promote entrepreneurship skill amongst the students. Seven Teams had participated in this food fest which had included 19 students from faculty of Arts and Commerce. NSS volunteers helped in event management with great enthusiasm and also served as cashiers. Specifically, they created college currency (tokens) which was used instead of Legal Tender (actual currency). Customers had to purchase token from the cashiers in lieu of legal tenders (actual currency) to purchase food from the stalls. Option for digital payment was also made available at the cash counter. In this event Collective turnover of all the food stalls was Rs.9035/-. Dr. Niyati Antani, Dr. Ijan Vaidya and Dr. Vijay Patel served as judges of this event. The Evaluation criteria included Taste, Nutritional value, healthiness & hygiene of food, Advertising campaign (marketing), stall management, turnover and customer satisfaction & response.

This event helped participants to learn and understand about the Business management skills like Planning, Demand Estimation, advertising campaign (marketing), stall management, Cost-Benefit Analysis, Price strategy, waste management, Quality Standards etc.

Food Fest got over whelming response from students as well as faculty members. Principal Dr. Himmat Bhalodiya purchased the tokens of highest amount and encouraged the students as well as staff by actively tasting the food from all the stalls and praising students personally. Not only organising committee members but all the faculty members and non-teaching staff also contributed in making this event successful.

Industrial Visit to AmulFed Dairy

Gujarat Arts and Commerce College (Evening), Ahmedabad

Report on Industrial Visit to AmulFed Dairy under “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” initiative jointly organized by IQAC, Department of Commerce and Accountancy and Entrepreneurship Development Cell

On 10/08/2023, the Entrepreneurship Development Cell in collaboration with the Department of Commerce and Accountancy of Gujarat Arts and Commerce College (Evening), Ahmedabad organized an educational visit to AmulFed Dairy, located in Bhat, Ahmedabad, Gujarat. A total of 28 students (17 Males and 11 Females) and 4 faculty members from college, including EDC committee member Prof. Riddhi Suthar, participated in this visit. This visit aimed to provide students with practical insights into the dairy industry and entrepreneurship opportunities within it.

The visit began with a warm welcome and orientation session. Students were briefed on the schedule and the objectives of the visit. They were introduced to the significance of the dairy industry in Gujarat and India.

The participants were given a comprehensive overview of AmulFed Dairy, including its history, mission and role in the dairy sector through a short film presentation. 


