

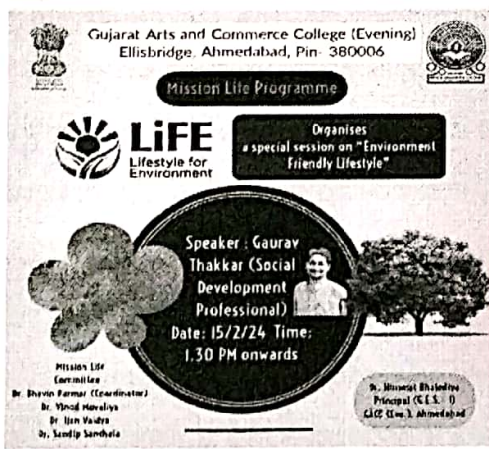

Under the Mission Life Project,
A lecture program was organized on the subject of
'Environment Friendly Lifestyle'.

The Indian government has initiated the Mission Life Project to raise environmental awareness among students in schools and colleges. Under this project, efforts are being made to raise environmental awareness among students through various programs focusing on energy conservation, water conservation, plastic reduction, and environmentally conscious lifestyle.



As part of this initiative, college's Mission Life Committee was organized a lecture on Environment Friendly Lifestyle by Mr. Gaurav Thakkar on February 15, 2024. The program was attended by college faculty and more than 70 students. Mr. Gaurav Thakkar is the Managing Trustee of the Sadhana Foundation, which has been working on environmental awareness in society for the past 15 years, collaborating with the government, cooperative sectors, and the United Nations. He is active members of the Nal Sarovar Bird Sanctuary's Conservation Committee.



The program began with a prayer and was followed by Mr. Bhavin Parmar, the coordinator of the Mission Life Committee, showing a video to

students explaining in detail about this project. In charge Principal of our

College Shri Bahadursinh Vaghela, urged students to participate in this project for the conservation of the environment, citing it as an excellent example of national service.

Mr. Thakkar started his lecture in his gentle style, mentioning that due to the globalization of modern times, the world is facing many challenges. In countries like India, we can observe significant changes in seasons. There is excessive heat in summers, sudden rainfall, and floods. The number of storms and cyclones is constantly increasing. The main reason behind all this is the indifference of society towards the environment.

He mentioned that when they were counting the bird population in Nal Sarovar, they noticed a decline in the number of birds coming from abroad. The main reason for this is the modern lifestyle. He also gave an example that earlier, we could see a lot of

birds in the countryside, but now due to the radiation from mobile towers, these birds are not found in villages as much as they used to be. He also mentioned that a serious question has arisen in the city of Ahmadabad, which is the issue of dying cows. He said that earlier, the expansion of Ahmadabad city was visible in the surrounding land, but now due to the construction of buildings, gardens,

roads, etc., on the land, the grazing land for cows has been destroyed. As a result, this issue has become very serious today.

Mr. Thakkar inspired the students with such examples to raise awareness about the environment. He urged students to contribute to the conservation of the environment by following some rules such as:

- Minimize use of electricity.
- Minimize use of water.
- Not using plastic products.
- Keeping dry and wet waste separate and disposing of it properly.
- Reducing the use of petrol to contribute to a clean environment.

He gave these rules to the students to follow and contribute to environmental conservation. The members of the Mission Life Committee, Dr. Vinod Movaliya, had suggested a pledge to the students for environmental conservation. After the program, students were served light refreshments.
