INTRODUCTION

The National Cadet Corps is the Indian Military Cadet Corps with its head Quarters at New Delhi. It is open to college students on voluntary basis.

NCC provides basic training to the students of colleges for different wings Army, Navy and Air Force. It aims to groom students into disciplined and patriotic citizens. NCC cadets are given the opportunity to participate in a host of adventure activities including Mountain Treks and Expeditions, Trekking, Parasailing, Sailing, Scuba Diving, Kayaking, Camel safari to hone leadership skills and enhance their character qualities. Various NCC Camps are held such as Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC), Basic Leadership Camp (BLC) Pre-Republic Day Camp (PRDC), Advanced Leadership Camp (ALC), Course at Himalayan mountaineering institute Darjeeling, Para Troopers Camp (PTC), National Integration Camp (NIC), Army Attachment, Republic Day Camp (RDC), Hiking and Trekking Camp, Thal SainikCamp (TSC). The main Focus of NCC is on instilling discipline in the souls of the cadets, besides fostering healthy competition for the ranks, while keeping the greater interest of the nation in mind to create prospective officers for the Armed Forces. The National Cadet Corps is the only organization of its kind, which imparts Leadership, Discipline, Integration, Adventure, Military, Physical and Community Development training to over 15 lakhs youth of the country.

ABOUT COLLEGE NCC

National Cadet Corps of Gujarat College (Evening), Ahmedabad has always been recognized as a responsible and disciplined organization in every aspect. Its dedication and commitment towards the nation and its interest has always been a priority for the organization. NCC of the college is an army wing NCC company and starts enrolment of cadets every year in the First week of August through a physical test which is followed by GD-PIs. Many activities are organized throughout the year and cadets actively take part in those events like Army Attachment Camp, IMA Attachment Camps, SSB Training Capsules, Parasailing Camps, Para Slithering Camps, Para Basic Courses, Mountaineering Camps, Trekking Expeditions, Rock Climbing Training, Thal Sainik Camp, Republic Day Camp, Youth Exchange Programme, National Integration Camps and Leadership Camps.

NCC Boys & Girls Division (SD & SW) of the college is running under guidance of Lt Vinod Movaliya. It is a part of 1 Gujarat Battalion NCC, Ahmedabad Group, Gujarat Directorate. The College has 105 NCC Cadets.

The College NCC helps cadets to improve their overall personality by teaching them leadership qualities, discipline, honesty, working in a team, time management, to have high self-confidence, being physically fit, service before self, social service, and responsibility of service towards motherland and to be a responsible citizen of India. The College NCC cadets actively participate various state/regional/national level organized camps and various social service activities organized in the college. They are also responsible to maintain discipline in various programs organized by the college.

NCC ENROLMENT

The selection of 1st year cadets for NCC Gujarat College (Evening) 1 GUJ BN Army wing (Senior Division and Senior Wing) was successfully conducted from 20-21 September 2022 at College Football ground under the leadership of principal Dr. Himmat Bhalodiya, ANO Lt.



Vinod Movaliya, SM Malkhar Singh, SUO Ayush Mishra, JUO Sudhanshu Gupta and UO Urvashi Tomar. The whole selection process was supervised by PI Staff of 1 GUJ BN NCC. The selection of cadets was held in three phases i.e. Phase 1 – Physical Tests, Phase 2 – Written Examination and Phase 3 – Personality Test.

All the participants were briefed about their selection process. ANO Lt. Vinod Movaliya gave his best wishes to the cadets for their events.

After the allocation of groups, applicants reported to their respective group leader who briefed them about all the events and other protocols to be followed by them during the events. The group leaders warmed up the applicants so that, they can perform their physical activities with ease. the group leaders further filled them up with “HIGH JOSH”.



INSTITUTIONAL TRAINING

Institutional training conducted at college is the mainstay of NCC training and is conducted



by Associate NCC Officer and Armed Forces personnel. The syllabus comprises Common Subjects and Service Subjects in the ratio 70:30. The Senior Wing/Division training is for three years and has 300 periods of training. The training year is from 01 Apr to 31 March. Training schedules planned for cadets

ensure that the optimum benefits of the organization reach maximum number of cadets. Emphasis is on practical training. Case study method of instruction, wherever possible, is made to facilitate active participation and better assimilation. Institutional training includes basic military training to the cadets as part of the curriculum and prepares them to join the Armed Forces.



CAMP TRAINING

Camp training is the practical manifestation of institutional training. The basic aim of Camps is to introduce cadets to a regimented way of life and helps in developing camaraderie, team work, leadership qualities, self-confidence, self-reliance and dignity of labour in the cadets. The cadets are exposed to the excitement of camp life where they apply the theoretical knowledge that they had gained in Institutional Training.

The following Camp trainings were organized during the year 2022-23.

Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC)



The Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC) is a local camp which is held within the State under the aegis of respective NCC Directorates. CATC was organized by the 1 GUJ BN NCC from 01-10 June 2022 at NCC Group Headquarter, Law Garden, Ahmedabad. All cadets of our college attended the Camp. The Commanding Officer of

1 GUJ BN NCC Lt Col Satheesh kumar did the briefing for the cadets. A total of 105 Cadets came for

the Camp where different activities were organized. Combined Annual Training Camp aims to introduce the cadets to a regimented way of life and helps in developing comradery, team work, leadership qualities and self confidence among the cadets. The cadets are exposed to the excitement of camp life where they apply the theoretical knowledge that they had gained in Institutional Training. It is mandatory for the cadets of Senior Division to attend at least two camps during their tenure being an NCC cadet to apply for the 'C' Certificate exam.

Thal SainikCamp (TSC)

Thal Sainik Camp is the second most important national camp after republic day camp and it is held at Delhi every year. It includes various events that our field signals/judging distance, health & hygiene, map reading, shooting, obstacle training, tent pitching, best cadet & line area competition. The camp also prepares the cadets for their B & C certificate and also it improves the stamina of the cadets as well. Inter group selection takes place and 4 pre-TSCs are conducted in the respective directorates and team is finalised for every event. This year All India Thal Sainik Camp was held in Delhi from 14th September 2022 to 25th September 2022.



Preparation for inter-group team starts 4 months before final team PRE-TSC-1 17th August 2022-24th August 2022 Teams from all groups competed in various events and tests were conducted on 21st Aug and the winners in each event were awarded medals in the closing ceremony. Two cadets from our college were selected in the group Gujarat group team, Cadet Priyanshi Khadke and UO Hitesh Tomar.

Rashtriya Ekta Diwas Camp SNIC

Special National Integration Camps as part of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Program are conducted to make cadets understand and value the rich heritage of cultures that forge unity despite the diverse languages, traditions and religions of our country.



Special National Integration Camp (SNIC) Camps are being organized for SD/SW

NCC Cadets of all Directorates at national level to foster a sense of unity and nationality amongst cadets hailing from different regions of the country with varying cultural background and traditions. With this in view, an SNIC Camp for SD/SW Cadets of all NCC Directorates will be held at Kevadiya, where the Statue of Unity is located from 07 Oct to 01 Nov 2022 by NCC Gp HQ Ahmedabad on behalf of NCC Dte Gujarat. It will be administratively supported by 1 Guj Girls Bn, Ahmedabad.

The aim of the SNIC was to give the participating cadets an exposure to adventure, endurance and teamwork to inculcate in them the values of self-discipline, integrity and team spirit.

Two cadets of our College, SUO Ayush Mishra & SGT Dipika Mahato were selected for the SNIC. It is a matter of great pride that two cadets from the college have been selected to represent the College in the SNIC. The both cadets were participated in “Ekta Diwas” parade on 31st October, 2022. The cadets were also participated in various activities like Drill, Cultural Map reading, Games etc.

ATTACHMENT TRAINING / ARMY ATTACHMENT CAMP (AAC)

Cadets derive immense value through attachment to the Armed Forces Units where they experience the functioning of military units and life in armed forces units.



Army attachment camp (AAC) was conducted by the NCC Gujarat Directorate in collaboration with the Indian Army from 03-23 May 2022 at Army Cantonment, Ahmedabad. In this camp, the five cadets of our college were trained the military tactics

including day and night warfare and also get familiar with the weaponry.

ADVENTURE BASED LEARNING

Adventure is the life blood of youth. Adventure training in the NCC provides knowledge to cadets of the topography as well as experience of different weather conditions and adventurous living under camp conditions. The whole aim is to inculcate a spirit of adventure, explorative inquisitiveness, develop stamina, endurance, discipline, courage, determination, comradeship, leadership leading to development of self-confidence, team

spirit and spirit-de- corps amongst NCC cadets. NCC cadets are given the opportunity to



participate in a host of adventure activities including Mountain Treks and Expeditions, Trekking, Parasailing, Sailing, Scuba Diving, Kayaking, Camel safari etc. Adventure based activities enable cadets to hone leadership skills and enhance their character qualities. Cadets with potential are

given opportunities to participate in expeditions requiring higher degree of expertise and proficiency.

Two trekking camps were organized by NCC during the year 2023-24 for all State NCC Directorates. Our College Cadet UO Teenakumari Pawar was selected for All India Girls Trekking Expedition at Ajmer, Rajasthan on 05 -12, November, 2022 and Cadet Ritik Gurud was selected for Jaisalmer Trekking Camp at Jaisalmer, Rajasthan on 01-10 November, 2022. The both cadets were participated in adventure activities.



REPUBLIC DAY CAMP

The Annual Republic Day Camp (RDC) is held at Garrison Parade Ground, Delhi Cantt every year from 01 Jan to 29 Jan. Selected NCC cadets from all States and Union Territories attend the camp. This camp represents all parts of India and is a 'Mini India' in itself.



The 2023 Republic Day Camp was inaugurated by Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar in the first week of January and culminated with the Prime Minister's Rally on January 28. It is a matter of great pride for a cadet to be selected to represent his/ her state in the Republic Day Camp. In the RDC cadets are given

opportunity to show their talent via flag area (painting), culture (dancing, singing & all), selections for YOUTH EXCHANGE & BEST CADET starts. Contingent of squad drill & guard of honour are trained.

The Prime Minister's Rally, the most prestigious event of the NCC Republic Day Camp is held on 28 January every year. The PM's Rally commences with the Guard of Honour presented to Hon'ble Prime Minister by NCC Cadets. Contingents from all State NCC Directorate participate in the March Past. Social activities being undertaken by NCC are displayed in the form of tableau. Cadets from various directorate participate in this rally wherein they display their skills in equestrian, parasailing, band display. The PM's Rally culminates with award of Prime Minister's Banner to the winning Directorate by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. The events are witnessed by a number of dignitaries that include Hon'ble Raksha Mantri, Raksha Rajya Mantri, three Service Chiefs and the Defence Secretary.

SOCIAL SERVICE AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Social Service activities are structured to inspire and encourage the cadets to participate voluntarily towards improvement of their physical and social environment and channelize their energies in the task of nation building.

The following Social Service programs were organized during the year 2022-23.

SwatchhBharat Abhiyan

The NCC cadets of Gujarat College (Evening) organized "Environmental Awareness Rally" under SWATCHH BHARAT SWASTH BHARAT ABHIYAN on 4 April 2022. The main purpose of this programme was to create awareness among the Citizens regarding cleanliness and its benefits. The College NCC unit had also organized cleanliness drive



on 15 August 2022. Our principal started the programme by cleaning the corners of the playground. All the cadets took pledge to clean our college campus and to make our city smart and clean.

Tree Plantation Drive

On 15 July 2022, a tree plantation drive was organized by Gujarat College Eco Club & NCC in College Campus. The objective of the initiative was to contribute towards environmental conservation, combat climate change, and promote awareness about the importance of trees



in maintaining ecological balance. The event brought together NCC Cadets, NSS volunteers and Staff members to participate in this noble endeavor.

In this tree Plantation program, Dr. Narayan Madhu Joint Director of Higher Education Department, Gujarat was present as the chief guest in this program. Puneet Sagar Abhiyan

NCC launched the latest phase of its nationwide flagship campaign 'Punit Sagar Abhiyan' on 30 May 2022 and continued till 5 June 2022, World Environment Day.

Around 100 cadets of the college participated in the campaign during this phase. NCC cadets were joined by NCC alumni, locals and tourists at several places. The waste collected during the campaign was disposed of in an environment friendly manner in collaboration with government/private agencies. The college NCC Cadets have taken the initiative of cleaning

the places near Ahmedabad city such as Kankariya Lake, Chandola Lake, Sabarmati riverfront, Law Garden till October 2022. For the awareness amongst the population of Ahmedabad city, NCC Cadets have organized an ‘Awareness Rally’ on 2nd April 2022. More than 100 students joined in this rally which covered 5 km areas between Gujarat



College campus to Gujarat University.

Puneet Sagar Abhiyan was launched by NCC to clean Sea Shores/Beaches and other water bodies including rivers & lakes, of plastic & other waste and increase awareness amongst the local population about importance of keeping the beaches and river fronts clean. The purpose of the Abhiyan is to educate locals and sensitize them about ‘Swachh

Bharat’. It is envisioned to increase the awareness amongst local population and future generations about importance of keeping the beaches and riverfronts clean.

The campaign has continued unabated with full fervor since its launch in December 2021. Drawing, poster making, essay writing, poetry, article writing, debate, etc. are also being conducted at various locations during the campaign.

Kargil ke Veero ko Gujarat ka Aabhar

EkMaiSauKeLiye is a Campaign Initiative started by the NCC Directorate Gujarat, Daman



and Diu, Dadra Nagar Haveli. As the name so clearly signifies the entire idea is based on the very words, Ek Mai Sau Ke Liye. A brainchild of Major General Arvind Kapoor, Additional Director General, NCC, Gujarat, Daman and Diu, Dadra Nagar Haveli who has just returned after a two-year tenure in Leh, Ladakh, the Campaign is a unique initiative, wherein the

large pool of NCC Cadets in the State, have galvanized themselves, as responsible and disciplined citizens of the Nation and come forward to meet their social obligations towards the Society they live in.

The first phase of the campaign started on May 2021. The fifth phase of the campaign was

More than 25000 cards were sent by NCC Gujarat Directorate to the brave soldiers protecting the country on the

Blood Donation Camp on Kargil Vijay Diwas

Kargil Diwas is celebrated on the 26th of July to rekindle the pride and valor of the soldiers who were part of Operation Vijay. The day is significant in history as it marks the victory of Indian soldiers in capturing the mountain heights that were occupied by the Pakistani army on 26th July 1999.



On 26 July 2022, the 23rd Kargil Victory Day was celebrated by Gujarat College (evening). On this day, a blood donation camp was organized and 30 bottles of blood were collected by 30 NCC cadets of the college. This blood was used for the brave soldiers protecting the country.

Tiranga Yatra

‘Har Ghar Tiranga’ is a campaign under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to encourage people to bring the Tiranga home and to hoist it to mark the 75th year of India’s independence. Our relationship with the flag has always been more formal and institutional than personal. Bringing the flag home collectively as a nation in the 75th year of independence thus becomes symbolic of not only an act of personal connection to the Tiranga

but also an embodiment of our commitment to nation-building. The idea behind the initiative is to invoke the feeling of patriotism in the hearts of the people and to promote awareness about the Indian National Flag.

Fire Rescue & Emergency Management Training

Fire safety training is an essential component of workplace safety protocols and general preparedness for emergencies. It equips individuals with the knowledge and skills necessary



to prevent fires, respond effectively in case of an outbreak, and minimize potential damages and injuries.

With an objective to create awareness, knowledge and imparted training on Fire Safety & Emergencies the College NCC & NSS

jointly organized a guest talk and fire disaster demonstration for the NCC Cadets & NSS Volunteers on 08 September 2022. The resource person was Mr. P. B. Raval, Fire Officer, Department of Fire and Emergency Services, Ahmedabad. The guest talk was



mainly focused on “Fire Disaster Management” especially on the precautions that we have to take in the emergency situations. In the talk he added the issues of fire, rescue and emergency responses to the students. After Interaction session, mock drill on fire disaster demonstration was also organized in the college ground. Through this program students learn how to extinguish the Fire and how to evacuate, Type of Fire extinguisher, how to use Fire extinguisher, Use of Fire hose reel/pipe, Use of Gas mask, Bitter, Blanket, Gum boot, Hook, Stretcher, Manila rope, Lock cutter and other equipment, Duty & Responsibility of Cordon team, Rescue team & First aid team etc.

Paid Homage to Freedom Fighters

The College NCC paid homage to freedom fighters on the 81st Anniversary of the historic Quit India Movement on 14 August, 2022. The aim of the event was to create awareness amongst the youth and NCC cadets on the contribution of freedom fighters in attaining Independence for the country.
