INTRODUCTION

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) continues to play a vital role in shaping the character and leadership qualities of youth across India. In the academic year 2024–25, NCC remained steadfast in its mission to instill discipline, patriotism, and selfless service among cadets through a wide array of activities, including drill training, social service, adventure camps, and awareness programs. The organization actively participated in national-level events, Republic Day and Independence Day celebrations, and contributed to community outreach initiatives such as blood donation drives, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, and environmental conservation campaigns. With a strong focus on physical fitness, civic responsibility, and nation-building, NCC has significantly impacted the personal growth of cadets while promoting unity and integration. This year marked yet another milestone in NCC's continued commitment to developing responsible citizens and future leaders of the country.

ABOUT COLLEGE NCC

The NCC of our college is affiliated with the 1 Gujarat Battalion, under Ahmedabad Group HQ and Gujarat Directorate, and functions as part of the Senior Division/Senior Wing. For the academic year 2024–25, the unit comprised a total strength of 105 cadets, including both boys and girls from various academic streams.

The College NCC has been actively involved in regular training activities such as drill, arms training, map reading, obstacle training, and personality development sessions. Cadets have participated in numerous NCC camps including Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC), Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB), National Integration Camp (NIC), and Republic Day Camp (RDC) selections.

The College NCC also contributed to social and community service through awareness rallies, blood donation camps, tree plantation drives, cleanliness campaigns under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, and disaster management awareness programs. Through a combination of discipline, service, and leadership training, the NCC has played a crucial role in shaping cadets into responsible and confident citizens, reflecting the core values and vision of the National Cadet Corps.

NCC ENROLMENT

As part of the annual NCC activities, the enrolment drive for first-year cadets for the academic year 2024–2025 was successfully conducted on 20-08-2024 at Gujarat College Football Ground. The process was overseen by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO), along with the NCC Committee members and PI staff from the First Gujarat Battalion NCC. The primary objective of the enrolment drive was to select disciplined, motivated, and physically fit students who are willing to serve and commit to NCC activities over the next three years.



An orientation session was organized to brief the students about the objectives, structure, and benefits of joining the National Cadet Corps. The enrolment process included document verification, physical fitness tests, and a personal interview to assess the candidates' interest and commitment. The response from students was overwhelming, and a large number of applications were received. After a fair and transparent selection process, a total of 43 cadets, including 21 boys (Senior Division) and 22 girls (Senior Wing), were enrolled.



The enrolment process was smooth and well-organized. Students showed great enthusiasm, and the response was overwhelming. Selected cadets will now begin their training as per the NCC calendar under the guidance of the ANO and PI staff.

INSTITUTIONAL TRAINING

Institutional training conducted at college is the mainstay of NCC training and is conducted by Associate NCC Officer and Armed Forces personnel. The syllabus comprises Common Subjects and Service Subjects in the ratio 70:30. The Senior Wing/Division training is for three years and has 300 periods of training. The training year is from 01 Apr to 31 March. Training schedules planned for cadets ensure that the optimum benefits of the organization reach maximum number of cadets. Emphasis is on practical training. Case study method of

instruction, wherever possible, is made to facilitate active participation and better assimilation. Institutional training includes basic military training to the cadets as part of the curriculum and prepares them to join the Armed Forces.

CAMP TRAINING

Camp training is the practical manifestation of institutional training. The basic aim of Camps



is to introduce cadets to a regimented way of life and helps in developing camaraderie, team work, leadership qualities, self-confidence, self-reliance and dignity of labour in the cadets. The cadets are exposed to the excitement of camp life where they apply the theoretical knowledge that they had gained in

Institutional Training.

The following Camp trainings were organized during the year 2024-25.

Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC)

The Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC) is one of the most important training activities of the NCC, aimed at developing discipline, leadership, and a sense of unity among



cadets. A group of 41 cadets from our institution participated in the CATC held at NCC Headquarter from 24-05-2024 to 02-06-2024. During the camp, cadets underwent rigorous physical training, participated in drill practice, map reading, weapon training, and various cultural and social service activities.

Sessions on personality development, disaster management, and national integration were also conducted. Cadets actively took part in competitions such as group singing, debate, and essay writing, showcasing their talents and team spirit. The camp not only enhanced the physical and mental strength of the cadets but also fostered discipline and camaraderie among participants from different institutions. The cadets returned with valuable experiences and a stronger



commitment to the values of NCC. It is mandatory for the cadets of Senior Division to attend at least two camps during their tenure being an NCC cadet to apply for the 'C' Certificate exam.

Rashtriya Ekta Diwas Camp SNIC

A selected cadet from our College had the privilege of participating in the Special National Integration Camp (SNIC) held at Kevadiya, Gujarat, near the iconic Statue of Unity, from 17-10-2024 to 01-11-2024. The camp brought together cadets from various states and regions, reflecting the true spirit of "Unity in Diversity." During the camp, cadets engaged in a range of activities including cultural performances, national integration sessions, educational visits, and interactions with eminent personalities. The highlight of the camp was a visit to the Statue of Unity and nearby historical and cultural landmarks, which provided cadets with a deeper understanding of India's rich heritage. Through group discussions, community living, and collaborative tasks, the camp successfully promoted mutual respect, teamwork, and national pride among cadets. "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) Camp"

As part of the national initiative to promote cultural harmony and strengthen the spirit of unity in diversity, selected NCC cadets from our unit participated in the Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) Camp held at Ujjain, Madhyapradesh from 23-09-2024 to 04-10-2024. adventure, explorative inquisitiveness, develop stamina, endurance, discipline, courage, determination, comradeship, leadership leading to development of self-confidence, team spirit and spirit-de-corps amongst NCC cadets. NCC cadets are given the opportunity to participate in a host of adventure activities including

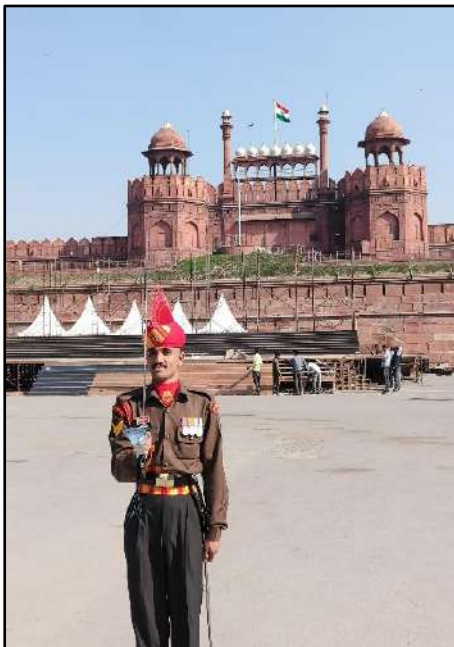

Cadets with potential are given opportunities to participate in expeditions requiring higher degree of expertise and proficiency.

Two trekking camps were organized by NCC during the year 2024-25 for all State NCC Directorates. Our College Cadet Ronak Rathod was selected for All India Trekking Camp at Amarkantak on 17 -24, June, 2024 and four Cadets were successfully completed for Basic Mountaineering Camp at Abu, Gujarat. The selected cadets were participated in adventure activities.

REPUBLIC DAY CAMP

The Annual Republic Day Camp (RDC) is held at Garrison Parade Ground, Delhi Cantt every year from 01 Jan to 29 Jan. Selected NCC cadets from all States and Union Territories attend the camp. This camp represents all parts of India and is a 'Mini India' in itself.

SOCIAL SERVICE AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Social Service activities are structured to inspire and encourage the cadets to participate voluntarily towards improvement of their physical and social environment and channelize their energies in the task of nation building.

The following Social Service programs were organized during the year 2024-25.

Swatchh Bharat Abhiyan

The NCC cadets of Gujarat College (Evening) organized “Cleanliness drive” under SWATCHH BHARAT SWASTH BHARAT ABHIYAN on 02-08 August 2024. The main purpose of this programme was to create awareness among the Citizens regarding cleanliness and its benefits. 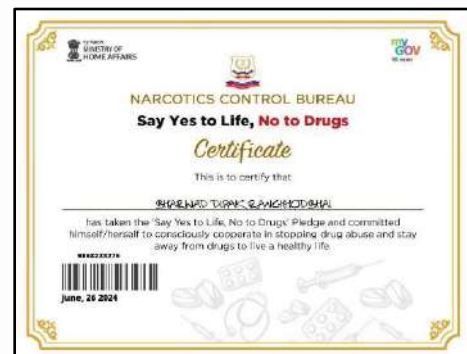
The activity was conducted under the guidance of the ANO and in coordination with the

The courses covered theoretical and practical aspects of fibre optics, including installation, maintenance, and troubleshooting. Cadets actively participated in hands-on training sessions, gaining valuable industry-relevant skills and certifications that support the Government of India's vision of a skilled and self-reliant youth.



"Special Nature Education Camp"

A Special Nature Education Camp was jointly organized by the NCC and the Eco Club with the support of the GEER Foundation, Gandhinagar, at the Devinamal Camp Site, Ahwa



(Dang) from 10-02-2025 to 12-02-2025, as part of a three-day stay camp aimed at promoting environmental awareness and conservation among youth. A total of 47 cadets participated in the camp, where they engaged in various nature-centric activities such as biodiversity walks, bird watching, ecological lectures, night trekking, and

interaction sessions with forest and wildlife experts.

The camp focused on sensitizing cadets to the importance of preserving natural habitats and understanding local ecosystems, especially within the rich biodiversity of the Dang forest region. The cadets also participated in group discussions, nature photography, and cleanliness drives in and around the campsite.
