Brief Description of Roles

1. Education Department, Government of Gujarat

 The Education Department is the apex body responsible for policy formulation and oversight of the education system in Gujarat, including school and higher education.

2. Commissionerate of Higher Education (CHE), Gujarat

• The Commissionerate of Higher Education functions under the Education Department and specifically handles administration and governance of government and grant-in-aid colleges in the state.

3. Principal

• The head of the institution; oversees academic, administrative, and strategic functions. Reports to the CHE.

4. IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell)

• Ensures the quality of academic and administrative processes. Plans seminars, innovations, and NAAC-related activities.

5. Academic Departments

- Heads of Departments (HoDs) lead their respective streams (Arts, Commerce).
- Faculty members deliver the curriculum, guide students, and participate in cocurricular activities.

6. Administrative Office

- Managed by the Registrar, this unit handles admissions, student records, fee collection (now through ERP), payroll, and university communications.
- Includes clerks, accountants, and support staff.

7. Library & IT Services

- The Library clerk manages book resources, journals, and digital access for students and faculty.
- IT support oversees digital infrastructure including ERP, student databases, and eresources.
