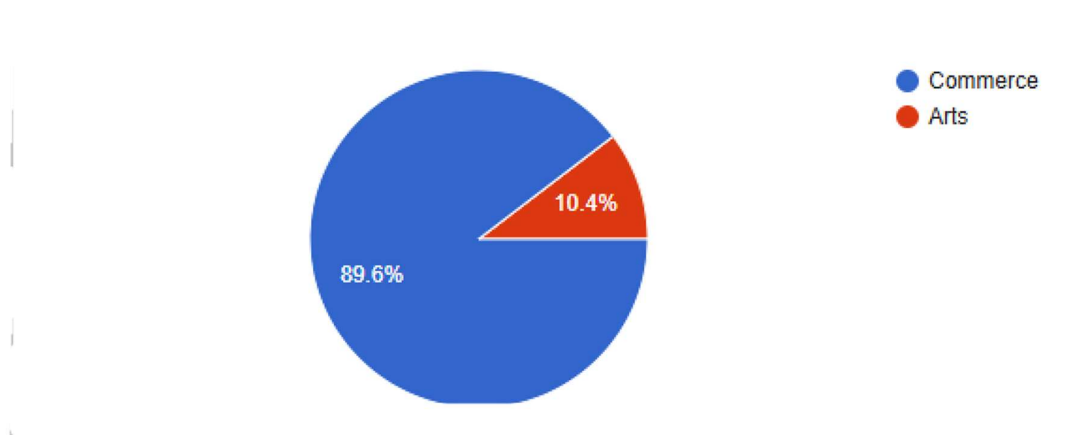
Students Satisfaction survey

1. What subject area are you currently pursuing?

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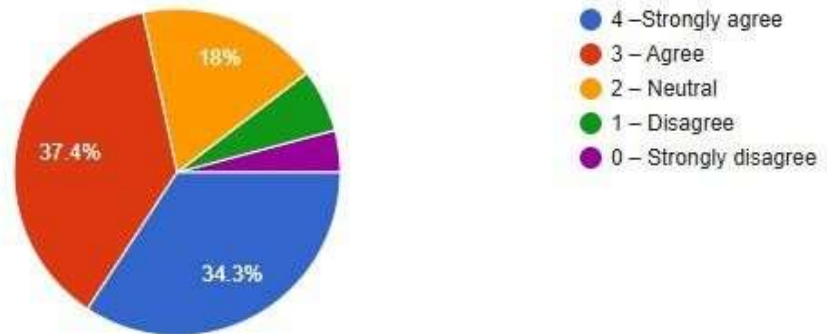


From the above chart indicate 89.6% of students from Commerce Faculty and remaining from Arts Faculty.

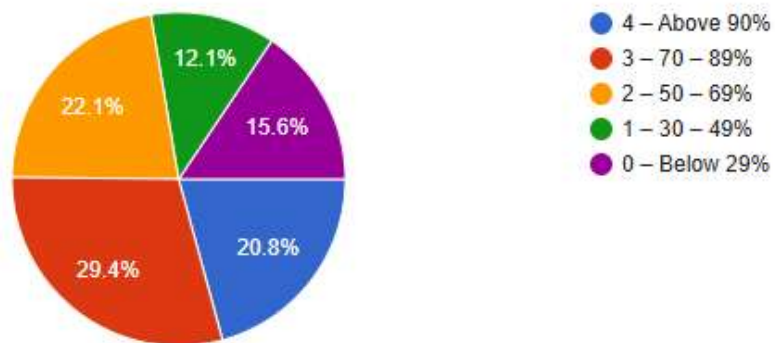

3. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projectors, Multimedia, etc.

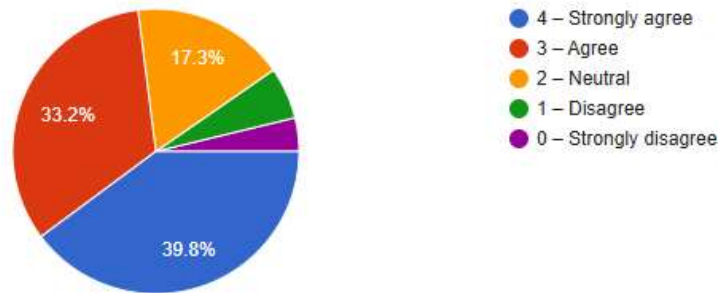
What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

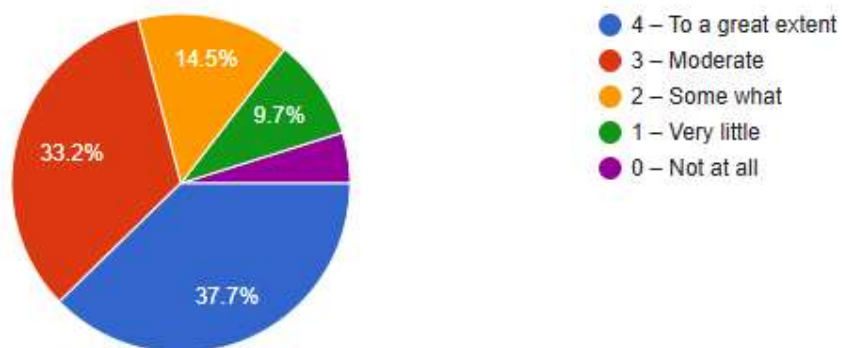
4. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

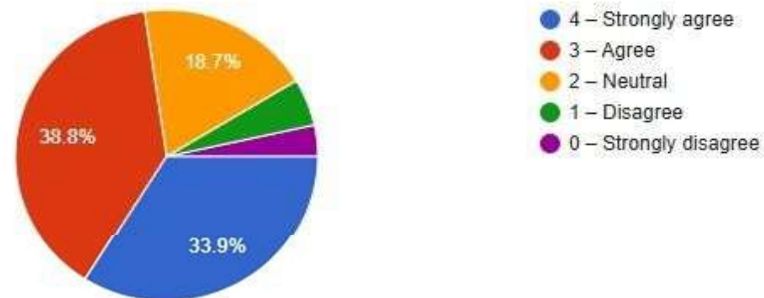

6. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

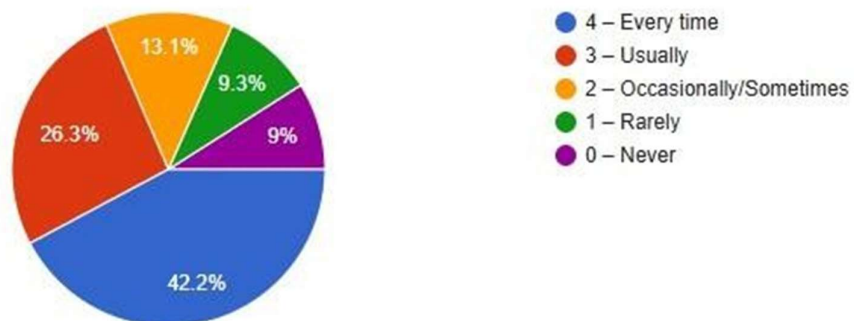

7. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

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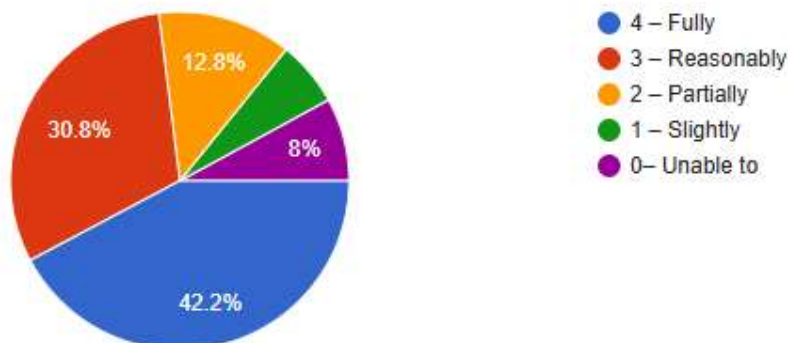

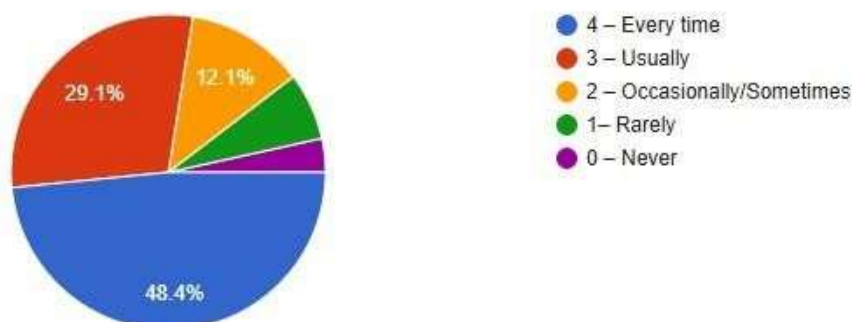

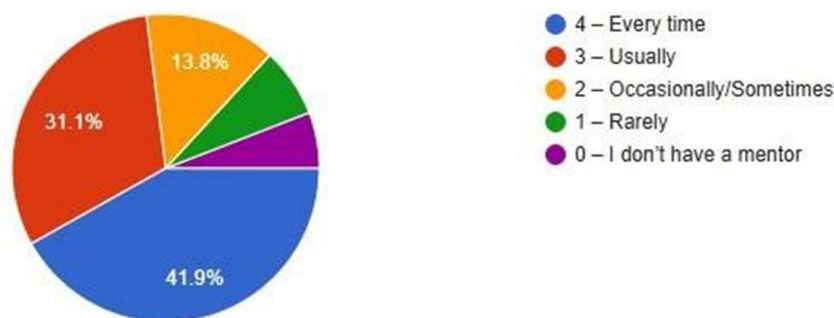

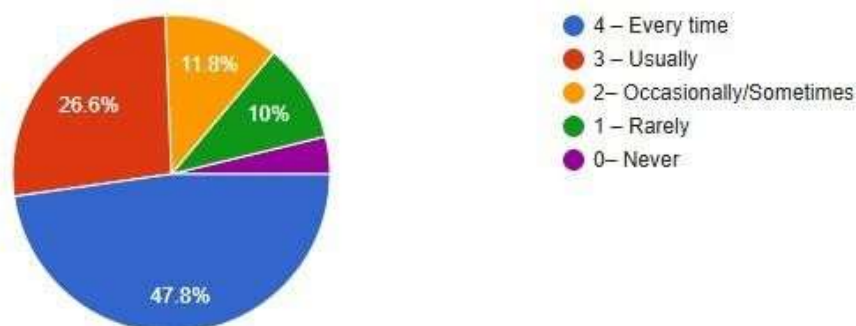

11. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.

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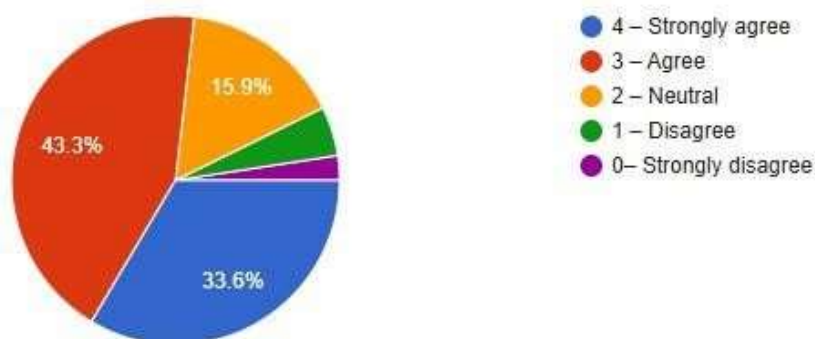

12. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

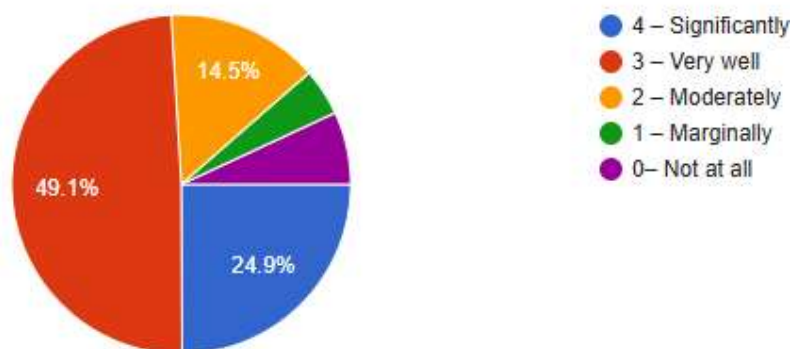
The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

13. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

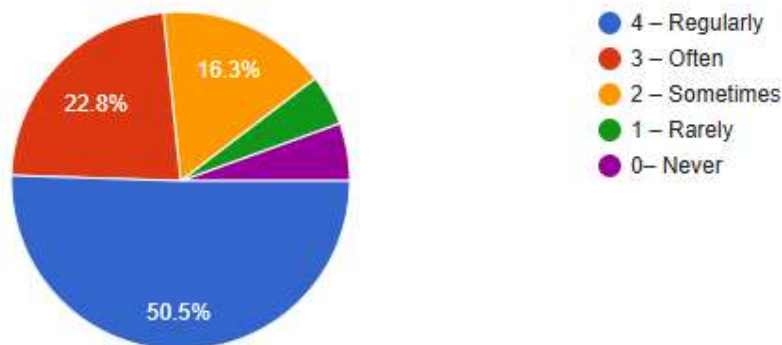

14. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

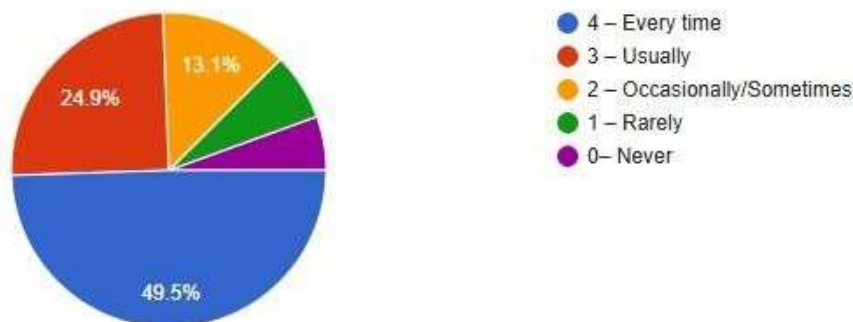

15. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

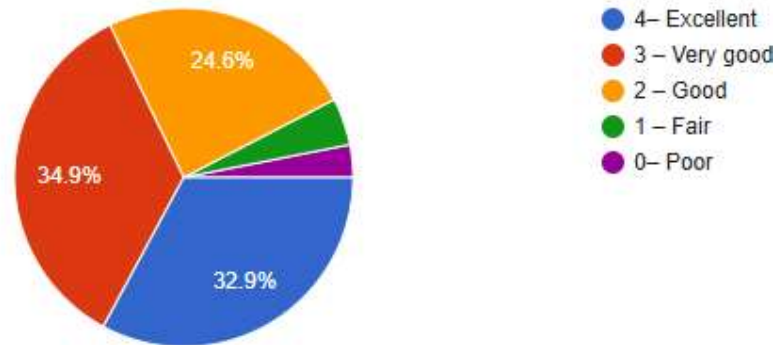
Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

16. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

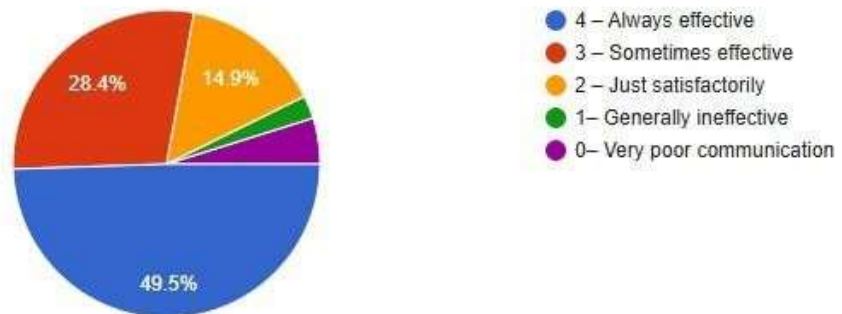
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

17. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

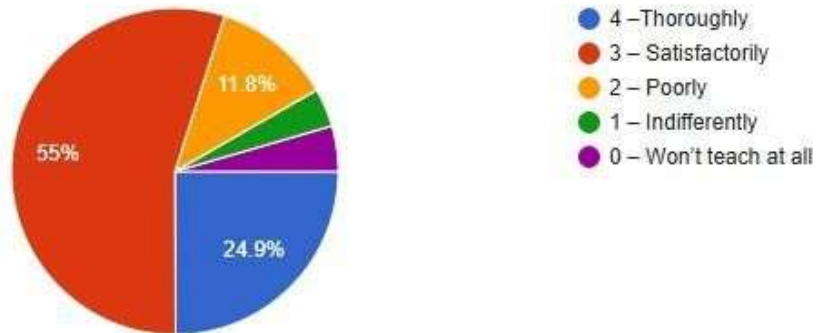
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

18. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

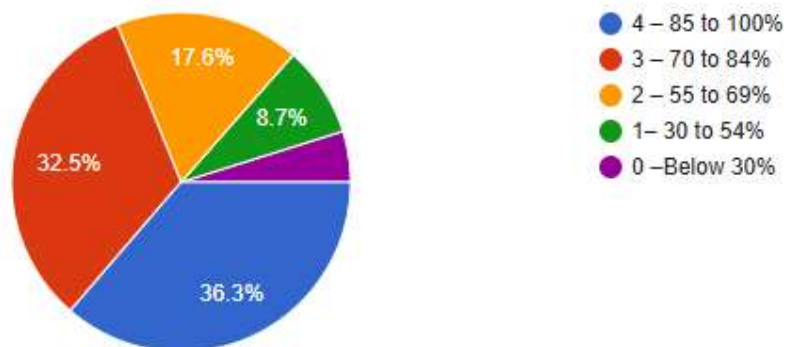
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

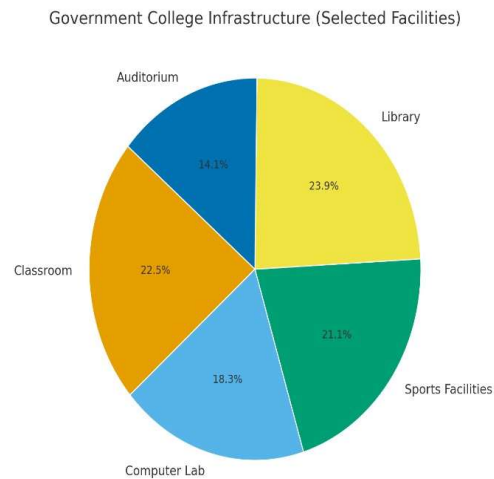
19. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

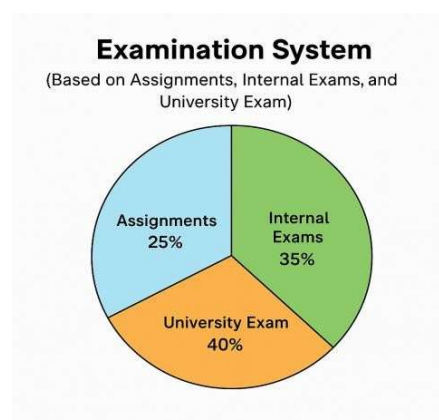
20. how is the infrastructure of college?



As per students' survey was conducted to assess the infrastructure of the Government College. The responses revealed satisfaction levels across various facilities. The **library and sports facilities** received higher ratings indicating well-maintained resources and spaces. **Classrooms and cleanliness** were rated fairly good (7/10). However, **classrooms with internet unable rating good in number**. Overall, while the academic infrastructure (library, classrooms, auditorium) is strong, students expect improvements in digital connectivity, and sports amenities.

Overall, the survey reflects that while the academic infrastructure of the college is much better, improvements are needed in digital facilities to enhance the student experience.

Also, the students are disappointed with a smaller number of factors, as the highest amongst the dissatisfaction levels is 20% in the year of 2022-2023.
